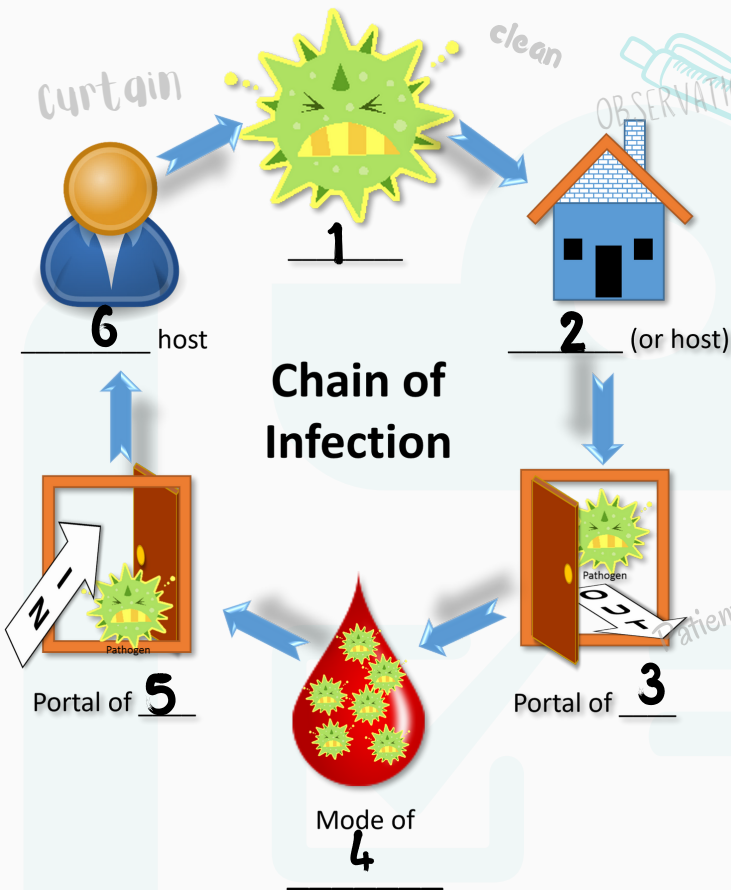

Barrier

- ✓ Provides **14** area for clean supplies
- ✓ Only touch **15** with clean hands
- ✓ Don't let supplies touch your **16**
- ✓ Get Barrier **17** before gathering supplies

Privacy Blanket

- ✓ Apply to keep patient **18** and provide privacy
- ✓ Used anytime a patient is **19** or undressed
- ✓ Pull down **20** underneath
- ✓ Don't snap or **21** blanket
- ✓ Remove at **22** of skill after removing gloves (if used)
